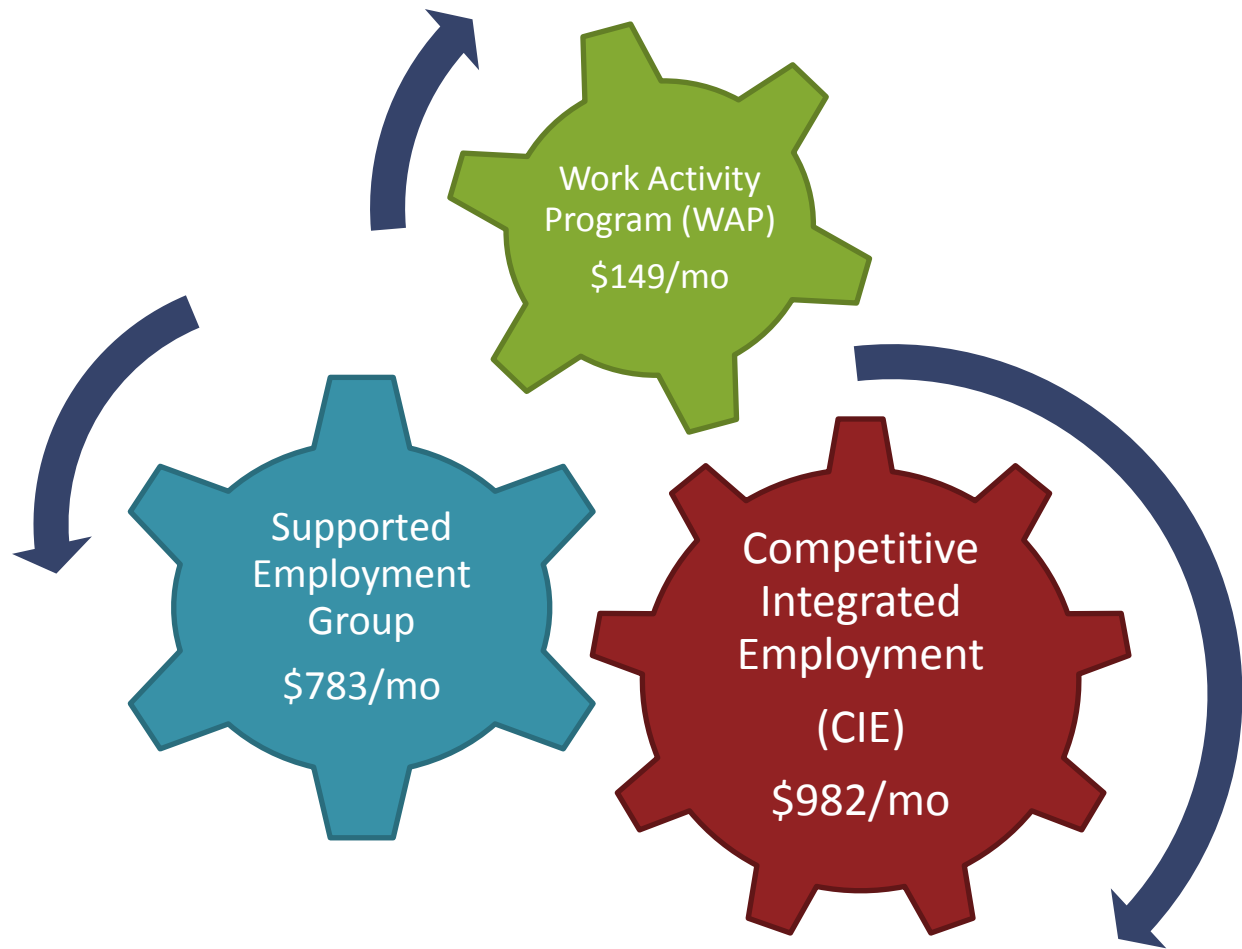
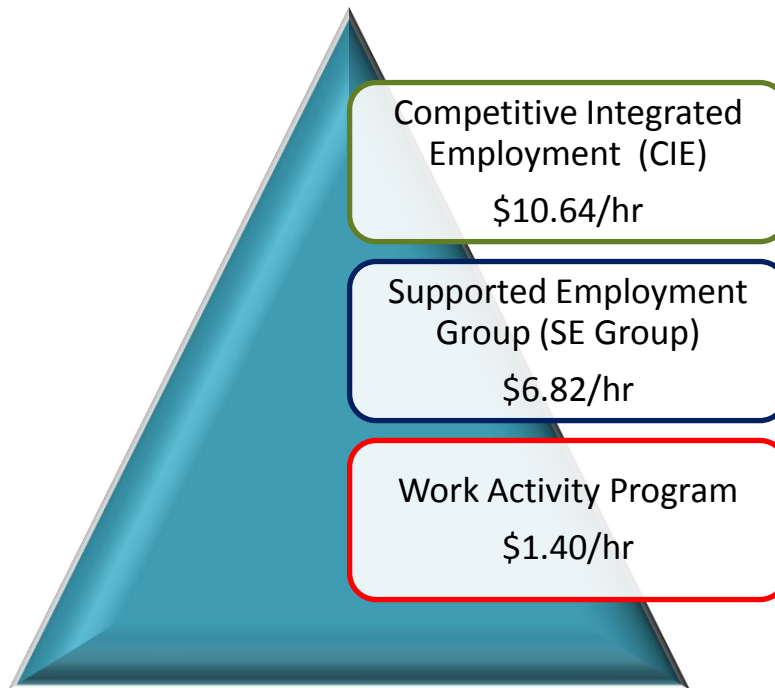


# Average Monthly Wages of SG/PRC Clients



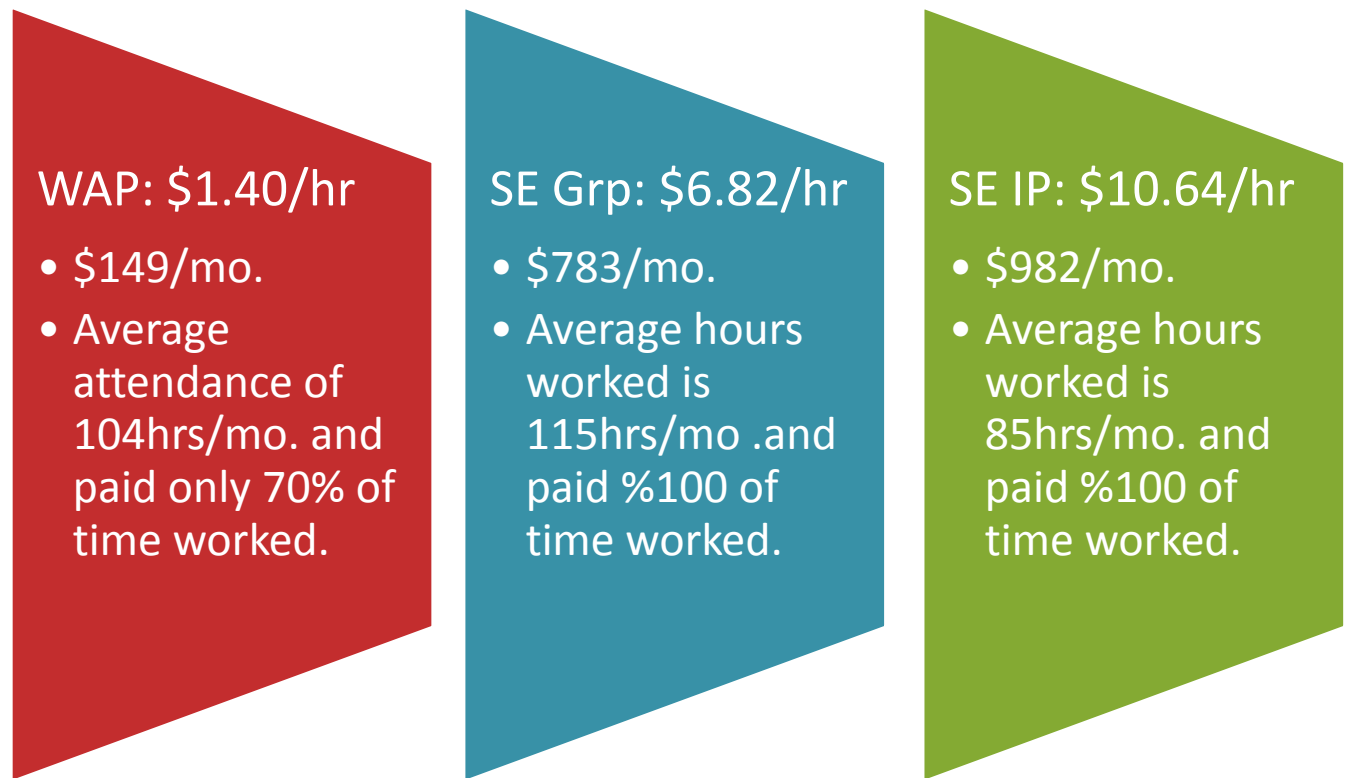
According to vendor reports, reported monthly wages for clients of San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Center working in Competitive Integrated Employment earned an average of \$982/mo while clients working in Supported Employment Group Placement earned \$783/mo. Clients in Work Activity Program earned \$149/mo. Clients in CIE work an average of 85 hrs/mo. Clients in SE Group work an average of 115hrs/mo, while clients attend WAP an average of 104 hrs/mo but approximately 70% of the attended time are paid time.

# Average Hourly Wages of SG/PRC Clients



In 2016, reported hourly wages for clients of San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Center working in Competitive Integrated Employment earned an average of \$10.64/hr while clients working in Supported Employment Group Placement earned \$6.82/hr. The wage gap between CIE and SE Group is \$3.82/hr. Clients placed in traditional Work Activity Programs are paid on average \$1.40/hr; that is a \$5.42 wage gap with SE Group and \$9.24 gap with CIE. In addition, clients in CIE earn above the prevailing wage of \$10/hr. Clients in CIE, earning prevailing wage or above is in keeping with SG/PRC's Employment First Policy of competitive integrated employment as the highest priority for working age individuals with disabilities.

# SGPRC Client Earnings and Time Worked

At the beginning fiscal year 2016/17, reported hourly wages for clients of San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Center working in Competitive Integrated Employment earned an average of \$10.64/hr and \$982/mo, while clients working in Supported Employment Group Placement earned \$6.82/hr and \$783/mo. The wage gap between CIE and SE Group is \$3.82/hr. Clients placed in traditional Work Activity Programs are paid on average \$1.40/hr and earn on average \$149/mo. The wage gap is significant at \$5.42 difference with SE Group placement and \$9.24 gap with CIE. Clients participating in CIE or SE job placements are paid 100% of the time worked, whereas clients participating in WAP are paid on average 70% of time attended. In addition, clients in CIE earn above the prevailing wage of \$10/hr. Clients in CIE, earning prevailing wage or above is in keeping with SG/PRC's Employment First Policy of competitive integrated employment as the highest priority for working age individuals with disabilities.
