<p>Can regional center offer more time to submit the paper copies for the proposals?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic proposals including any attachments are due by June 4th no later than 4pm. • Required paper copies can be received by no later than June 5th at 4pm. • Paper copy requirement has been extended as a courtesy only because of the close deadlines for this RFP. • Proposals will be disqualified if paper copy not received by SG/PRC.
<p>Is it expected to transition 20-25 individuals for the North and 20-25 for the South or is it 20-25 individuals total?</p>	<p>20-25 in total per year</p>
<p>Can regional center provide a completed Attachment F as a sample?</p>	<p>We do not have a sample but as you are completing the attachment do note that it is important to capture all cost associated with the service. It is also helpful to include a narrative that can explain the proposed budgets for start-up and ongoing costs for this service.</p>

<p>Provide more information about the "No reject / No failure" language within the RFP?</p>	<p>We expect the selected applicant(s) to work with all who are referred.</p>
<p>Speak more about the services regional center is looking for via the intensive transition services?</p>	<p>We expect this to be a one stop comprehensive service which will be responsible in the successful transition of individuals currently placed at an IMD within California into a community setting. This service should have access to clinicians and other professional staff to assure that the needed resources/services the clients' needs to be successful with the transition are in placed prior to completion of the intensive transition service.</p>
<p>Please talk a little about Transition of an individual from IMD</p>	<p>This requires coordination from with the IMD and their staff as well as the targeted community service provider. Additional coordination will need to occur to ensure appropriate generic resources are established within the community the person will or is residing in.</p>

<p>Is it required to have an office in both Alta Regional Center and SG/PRC?</p>	<p>Yes</p>														
<p>Will the intensive transition services start before or after July 2018?</p>	<p>After the project is awarded, the services should start as soon as the ongoing agreement, program design, and rates are established the service should begin. Ideally, this should be completed and ready by the fall of 2018.</p>														
<p>Is there a known percentage for the individuals who are judicially involved at the IMD's currently?</p>	<p>No, but expect that some will have court involvement or be on probation, parole, or have existing sex offense. It is possible and likely that many will be in high risk for any of the items listed above.</p>														
<p>When is Program Design required to be completed?</p>	<p>No later than 90 days from the startup agreement.</p>														
<p>When will contract required to be signed by?</p>	<p>Startup will need to be signed no later than June 30, 2018</p>														
<p>If an agency responds to provide services for both Regional Center areas (North and South) in a proposal for the total of providing services for the 20-25 individuals per year, is it possible that a decision would be made to only award that provider either the North or South and not both?</p>	<p>For those applicants that apply to provide services to both regions, it is possible that they may be awarded both north and south or possibly just one region.</p>														
<p>When submitting for both; do you want a budget that identifies both teams or would you like it broken out?</p>	<p>Applicants seeking to provide services to both regions, but willing to accept an award for just one region, should consider submitting a budget that reflects services for both regions as well as a budget reflecting services for just one region.</p>														
<p>Several questions have asked regarding which IMD's are clients exactly at. The answer provided today is reflective of data obtained in January 2018.
