

What is the San Gabriel Pomona Regional Center?

San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Center is one of 21 regional centers in California operated by private nonprofit corporations which contract with the State Department of Developmental Services.

The regional center coordinates services for people with developmental disabilities and their families. The goal of this coordination is to secure services and supports which maximize opportunities and choices in living, working and learning in the community.

What is a Developmental Disability?

A developmental disability includes the following:

- ♦ Mental Retardation
- ♦ Cerebral Palsy
- ♦ Epilepsy
- ♦ Autism
- ♦ Other Conditions Closely Related to Mental Retardation

The disability must have originated before the age of 18, be expected to continue indefinitely, and constitutes a substantial handicap for the individual. A developmental disability does not include solely physical, learning, and psychiatric conditions.

- Information and Referral

- Purchase of Certain Services

Are There Fees for Regional Center Services?

There are no fees for most services provided. There may be a charge for services provided to minors who are receiving 24 hour residential care.

As of January 1, 2005, there is a Family Cost Participation Program for parents of children ages 3 to 17 who are receiving respite, day care or camp services and do not have MediCal.

What is Our Mission Statement?

San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Center works in partnership with individuals with developmental disabilities their families and the community, to promote choice, empowerment, independence, and full integration into community life.

The Regional Center represents the community in supporting and advancing the intent and entitlement of the Lanterman Developmental Disabilities Services Act through services such as assessment, advocacy, service coordination, education, training, communication, resource development and prevention services.

San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Center serves the following communities in the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys of Los Angeles County:

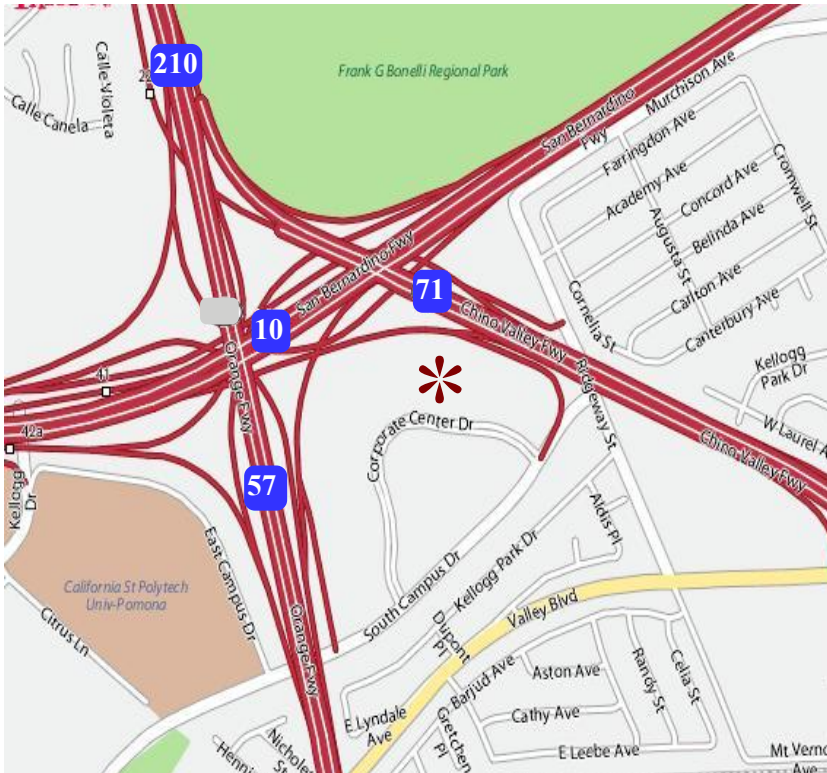
