LACC Project Summary for SG/PRC FY 25-26

SG/PRC initial LACC Plan included hiring two Language Access & Cultural Specialist to oversee the implementation of the plan and assist the center in understanding the diverse cultural and linguistic needs of our community. SG/PRC current plan reflects Fiscal Year 2025-2026, beginning July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. The total allocation amount for current fiscal year is: \$891,213.00

SG/PRC's Language Access and Cultural Competency Plan include the following:

- Build internal capacity by retaining staff to implement activities (Trilingual LACC Specialist to support the Asian community, Bilingual LACC Specialist to support the Hispanic, Black/African American, Deaf+, and LGBTQIA+ communities and a Community Outreach Specialist).
- Increase consumer experience and service access with bilingual and bicultural staff.
- Provide live interpretation in all public meetings and workshops in ASL, Chinese, Korean, Spanish and Vietnamese, as well as translate materials into threshold languages. Ensuring translation quality control by using consultant.
- Host community engagement gatherings and family workshops for the languages and cultures served to provide service access information, generic resources and to strengthen partnership with those groups
- Host Family Orientations & Workshops to improve access to information and Regional Center services.
- Develop culturally sensitive training modules, video resources, publication, brochures and materials for diverse communities in their native languages.
- Outreach to diverse communities by attending local community events hosted by cities and school districts to bring awareness of developmental disabilities and Regional Center services available to its diverse community members.
- Implement Language and Cultural Training for Regional Center staff to ensure effective communication and understanding of the focus population.
- Collaborate and develop new partnerships with Community Based Organizations (CBO's) to implement LACC activities.
